Cast of Characters

NARRATOR - FAIRY TELLER
LITTLE FLUFFY CLOUD
SUN

*Performance requirements: a box, about containing seven ribbons, about 36" long.
Each a different color of the rainbow. (red, orange, yellow, green, bright blue, dark blue,
violet.)*

PLAY BEGINS

The Narrator-A fairy appears on the scene.

NARRATOR - FAIRY TELLER

I am your Fairy Tale teller. Today I will tell you a fairy tale about diligence,
responsibility, generosity, and what make us all happier. . . Welcome to Little Fluffy
Cloud and Sun!

Summer . . . Early morning . . . Little Fluffy Cloud is cleaning the sky as she always does.
Today, she is looking at the early morning smudges requiring her attention, and
grumbles . . .

A Little Cloud appears on the scene and begins to wipe the sky.

LITTLE FLUFFY CLOUD (*resentfully*)

The sky is so big and I am so small! How can I clean it all? This job is too hard for me!

(stops wiping and looks around)

Maybe Wind can help me! She looks around again, sighs, then continues working very
slowly.

Little Fluffy Cloud continues to grumble, sighs and looks around, before continuing to

slowly wipe the sky again. Sun appears on the scene.

NARRATOR - FAIRY TELLER
Sun wakes up and sees Little Fluffy Cloud.

SUN (*cheerfully*)
Good morning!

LITTLE FLUFFY CLOUD
Maybe for some people it's a good morning, but not for everyone!

NARRATOR - FAIRY TELLER
She begins to clean the sky so forcefully that it is a wonder a hole didn't appear.

SUN (*smiling*)
Is it so hard to clean our sky?

LITTLE FLUFFY CLOUD
Yes! Because the sky is so big and I'm so small!

SUN (*smiling*)
When you don't think about it, you can accomplish so much very easily.

Sun smiles and spreads her warm rays more brightly in the morning sky.

LITTLE FLUFFY CLOUD (*looks around*)
It would be better if someone helped!

Sun rises higher and brighter in the sky.

SUN
If you expect help, you become unhappy if it's late, or never comes.

LITTLE FLUFFY CLOUD (*sighs*)
But my work is hard, and there's so much of it!

SUN
Are you tired?

Sun gently stroked Little Fluffy Cloud with her soothing rays.

LITTLE FLUFFY CLOUD
Not really . . . But . . . (*stubbornly*)
It's just that the sky is so big, and I'm so small! It's so much work for me!

SUN (*smiling*)

Talking to yourself again? Look at me . . . I have a lot of work too! I give my warmth and light to everyone on Earth every day!

Sun spreads Little Fluffy Cloud warm rays.

SUN

When you do something with generosity and joy, you are never tired. Look how clean our sky has become! You're doing a wonderful job!

NARRATOR - FAIRY TELLER

Little Fluffy Cloud doesn't want to listen. She is glancing sideways at Sun, puffing up, she sprays Sun with her rain.

Droplets sprinkle from her all over the sky. Sun laughs gaily. Each drop of rain reflecting Sun's smile like a mirror.

The many small shiny drops fall down to Earth and create a rainbow bridge. The amazing ribbons of color – red, orange, yellow, green, blue, indigo, violet – weave together into a beautiful bridge!

Little Fluffy Cloud looks around in awe and wonder.

LITTLE FLUFFY CLOUD

Oh-h . . . It's a miracle! Thank you so much!

NARRATOR - FAIRY TELLER

Little Fluffy Cloud isn't grumbling anymore. How can she grumble in the presence of such beauty?

Sun and Little Fluffy Cloud laugh together, rejoicing at how the drops of rain and sun's rays create a magically, colorful bridge between sky and Earth!
